# Baptism of Our Lord Readings

## Acts 10:34–43

**P**eter began to speak to  
*Cornelius and his  
household*: "I truly  
understand that God shows no  
partiality, but in every nation

anyone who fears him and does  
what is right is acceptable to him.

"You know the message he  
sent to the people of Israel,  
preaching peace by Jesus  
Christ—he is Lord of all. That  
message spread throughout  
Judea, beginning in Galilee after  
the baptism that John  
announced: how God anointed  
Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy  
Spirit and with power; how he  
went about doing good and  
healing all who were oppressed  
by the devil, for God was with  
him. We are witnesses to all that  
he did both in Judea and in

**T**hen Jesus came from

for us in this way to fulfill all  
righteousness."

Then he consented. And
